Eleanor joined WBQG in 2015 and was the past secretary and past president of WBQG. As a leader she told me that she wanted the members to have fun and would have some unique games for us to play and laugh during guild meetings. Eleanor was also a member of Quilting in the Pines (QUIP).

Eleanor loved a quilting challenge. This is where she excelled with her creativity and her quilting flair. Eleanor was an artist. She loved to teach and even created a YouTube video, "Longarm Quilting with a Pantograph Pattern". In 2017 she won Stitch Craft's Viewers' Choice award in their fabric challenge. The fabric was a black on white print of buildings that Eleanor incorporated into her self-portrait "Eleanor". This quilt was even showcased at the Daytona American Quilters Society (AQS) quilt show in 2019 in the "Pop Up Quilt Party." Eleanor was an accomplished quilter and won awards at the Broward Quilting Expo (BQE) in 2019 and 2021.




