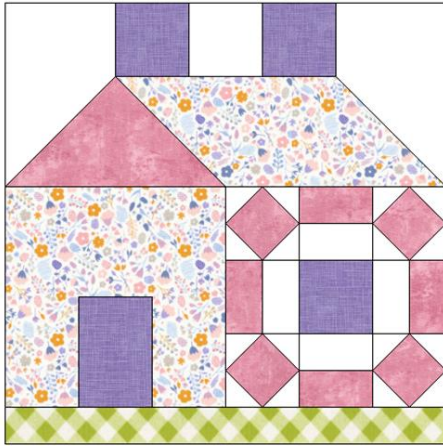


JULY BLOCK

Finish block 12" square

Please read all instructions before cutting and sewing.



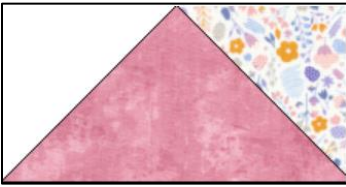
Cutting Instructions			
Fabric	Size	Cut	
Background	3 ½ x 2 ½ rectangles	2	A
	2 ½ square	1	B
	3 ½ x 3 ½ squares	2	C
Purple	2 ½ square	2	D
	3 ½ x 2 ½ rectangle	1	E
Print	3 ½ x 6 ½ rectangles	2	F
	3 ½ square	1	G
	3 ½ x 2 ½ rectangles	2	H
	Pink	3 ½ x 6 ½ rectangle	1
Green	1 ½ x 12 ½ rectangle	1	J

Sewing Instructions All seam allowances are ¼ inch.

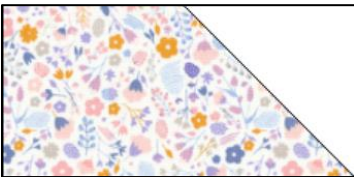
1. Sew Fabrics A – D – B – D – A. Finished unit should measure 2 ½" x 12 ½".



2. Make Flying geese with Fabrics C – I – G. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Fabrics C and G squares. With right side facing, layer Fabric C square on left side of Fabric I. Sew on the drawn line and trim ¼" away from the seam. Repeat on the right side with Fabric G square. The Flying geese should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½".



3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Fabric C. With right side facing, layer Fabric C square on right side of Fabric F. Sew on the drawn line and trim ¼" away from the seam. Unit should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½".



4. Sew Fabrics H - E - H. Finished unit should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½".



Then sew one Fabric F on the top. Finished unit should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½".

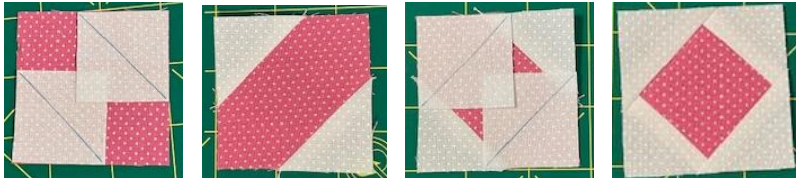

5. **Rolling Stone Block** 6" x 6" (6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished)

Cutting Instructions			
Fabric	Size	Cut	
Background	1 1/2 squares	16	AA
Background	1 1/2 x 10	1	BB
Pink	2 1/2 square	4	CC
Pink	1 1/2 x 10	1	DD
Purple	2 1/2 square	1	EE

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the AA squares. With right sides together, place 2 AA fabrics on the top right and bottom left of CC square. Sew on the drawn lines. Press and trim. Repeat on the opposite sides. Press and trim to 2 1/2 x 2 1/2 inch square. Repeat steps to make 4 Rolling Stone blocks in total.



Sew Fabrics BB and DD right sides together, it should measure 2 1/2" x 10". Cut unit to get four 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares".



Assemble unit as shown below. Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".



6. Assemble block. Unfinished block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
