

## JUNE BLOCK

Finish block 12" square

Please read all instructions before cutting and sewing.



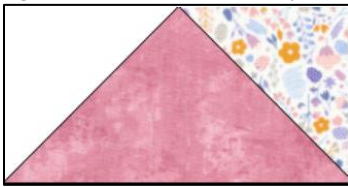
Cutting Instructions			
Fabric	Size	Cut	
Background	3 ½ x 2 ½ rectangles	2	A
	2 ½ square	1	B
	3 ½ x 3 ½ squares	2	C
Purple	2 ½ square	2	D
	3 ½ x 2 ½ rectangle	1	E
Print	3 ½ x 6 ½ rectangles	2	F
	3 ½ square	1	G
	3 ½ x 2 ½ rectangles	2	H
Pink	3 ½ x 6 ½ rectangle	1	I
Green	1 ½ x 12 ½ rectangle	1	J

Sewing Instructions All seam allowances are ¼ inch.

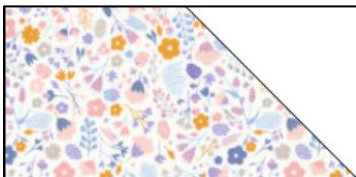
1. Sew Fabrics A – D – B – D – A. Finished unit should measure 2 ½" x 12 ½".



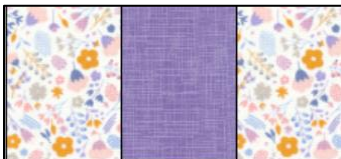
2. Make Flying geese with Fabrics C – I – G. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Fabrics C and G squares. With right side facing, layer Fabric C square on left side of Fabric I. Sew on the drawn line and trim ¼" away from the seam. Repeat on the right side with Fabric G square. The Flying geese should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½".



3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Fabric C. With right side facing, layer Fabric C square on right side of Fabric F. Sew on the drawn line and trim ¼" away from the seam. Unit should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½".



4. Sew Fabrics H - E - H. Finished unit should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½".



Then sew one Fabric F on the top. Finished unit should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½".



5. **Economy Block** 6" x 6" (6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished)

Cutting Instructions			
Fabric	Size	Cut	
Print	3 ½ square	1	AA
Purple	3 squares	2	BB
Pink	4 squares	2	CC

Cut Fabrics BB and CC on the diagonal once. Sew two Fabrics BB to the left and right side of fabric AA. Press. Then sew the other two Fabrics BB to the top and bottom. Press and trim excess. Sew two Fabrics CC to the left and right side of center block. Press. Then sew the other two Fabrics CC to the top and bottom. Press and trim excess. Your block should be 6 ½ x 6 ½ square. (Recommendation: Trim ¼ inch from the edge so your points look good).



6. Assemble block. Unfinished block should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½".
