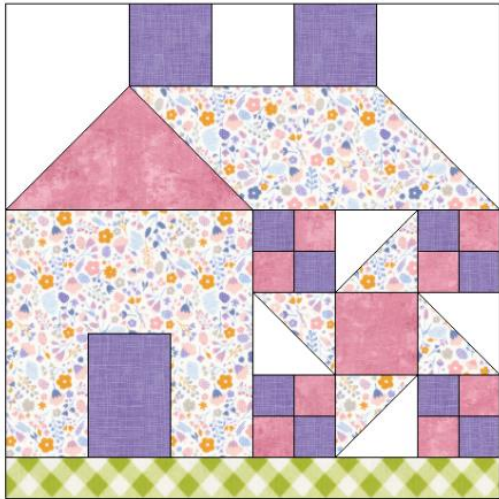


NOVEMBER BLOCK
Finish block 12" square

Please read all instructions before cutting and sewing.



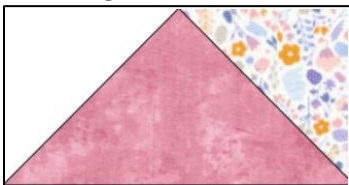
Cutting Instructions			
Fabric	Size	Cut	
Background	3 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles	2	A
	2 1/2" square	1	B
	3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares	2	C
Purple	2 1/2" square	2	D
	3 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle	1	E
Print	3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles	2	F
	3 1/2" square	1	G
	3 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles	2	H
Pink	3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle	1	I
Green	1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle	1	J

Sewing Instructions All seam allowances are 1/4 inch.

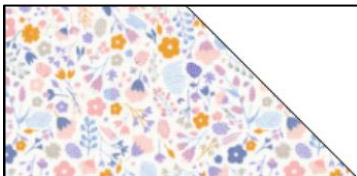
1. Sew Fabrics A – D – B – D – A. Finished unit should measure 2 1/2" x 12 1/2".



2. Make Flying geese with Fabrics C – I – G. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Fabrics C and G squares. With right side facing, layer Fabric C square on left side of Fabric I. Sew on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam. Repeat on the right side with Fabric G square. The Flying geese should measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".



3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Fabric C. With right side facing, layer Fabric C square on right side of Fabric F. Sew on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam. Unit should measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".



4. Sew Fabrics H - E - H. Finished unit should measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".



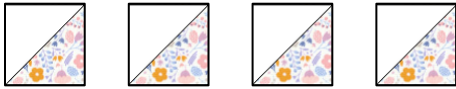
Then sew one Fabric F on the top. Finished unit should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".



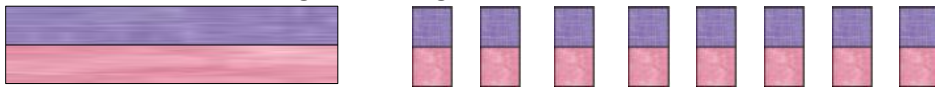
5. Block 6" x 6" (6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished)

Cutting Instructions			
Fabric	Size	Cut	
Background	3" squares	2	AA
Print	3" squares	2	BB
Purple	1 1/2" x 12" rectangle	1	CC
Pink	1 1/2" x 12" rectangle	1	DD
Pink	2 1/2" square	1	EE

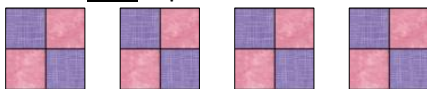
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Fabrics AA. With right sides together, layer one AA and one BB Fabric. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press open. Trim to a 2 1/2" square if needed. Repeat steps with the other AA and BB Fabrics. You should have four 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" HSTs.



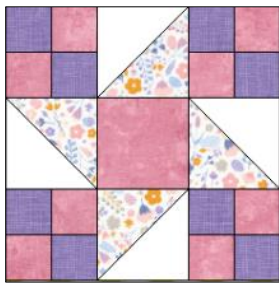
Sew Fabrics CC and DD right sides together, it should measure 1 1/2" x 12". Cut into eight 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" units.



Create four 4-patches as shown below, they should measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square.



Assemble unit as shown below. Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".



6. Assemble block. Unfinished block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
